**Ski Lift Tickets and Flights** - In order to qualify for **flights into Crested Butte for \$500 or less, flights must be reserved in advance of 60 days prior to departure date (by December 27<sup>th</sup>)**, originate from a large hub airport and connect into and out of Gunnison/Crested Butte Airport from either Dallas, TX (DFW), Houston, TX (IAH), Chicago, IL (ORD), or Los Angeles, CA (LAX) in both directions and booked through Crested Butte Vacations. **Call our office and we will give you our contact information.** This is a one stop shopping – you will be able to order great priced air, **2 out of 3 day ski lift tickets for \$98**, ski school, rentals, and shuttle, etc. The shuttle runs to town every 15 minutes during ski season. Once you arrive in Crested Butte you will not need a car.

**Dining & Entertainment** - The dining options in the Gunnison Valley abound. Crested Butte restaurants provide cuisine from burgers to sushi to Mexican to Italian to upscale. There are also more than 30 bars, live music almost every night of the week and apres ski entertainment.
