Day 3 Cruising Chatham and Icy Straits - search for marine mammals, with water & land ops

Day 4 Peril Strait/Sitka on your own

Day 5 Frederick Sound - whale watching and ops

Day 6 Port Houghton - beach walks, kayaking

Day 7 Tracy OR Endicott Arm - glacier and fjord sightseeing, skiff ops

Day 8 Juneau
